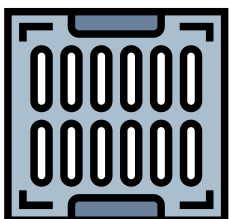

# Vocab Cheat Sheet

Stormwater - the water that falls as rain or snow into our environment, which flows directly into **streams**

Pervious Surface - soft places where stormwater can soak in, like a **field** or a **garden**

Impervious Surface: hard places that stormwater runs off, like a parking lot, sidewalk, roadway, or roof

Green Infrastructure - **trees**, **rain barrels**, **rain gardens**, and **ponds** help keep the water where it falls

Gray Infrastructure - storm drains, downspouts, pipes, and culverts help transport water away

Pollutants - **litter**, **dog poop**, **oil**, **loose dirt**, and **leaves** all get washed into our waters. They can hurt our animal friends, like **bugs**, that live in the water



Keep it **clean** for those **downstream!**
